### Reception of students:

### BRING THE FOLLOWING:

1. Your signed legal contract initialled on each page by ALL undersigned parties
2. Proof of payment for the registration fee (R 8 000)
3. Your signed legal lease agreement initialled on each page by ALL undersigned parties (if applicable)
4. Proof of payment for the commune registration fee if applicable (R 2 200/R 2 500)
5. Outstanding application documents (Application Form, copies of ID's, medical aid card)

### **Kick-start Camp**

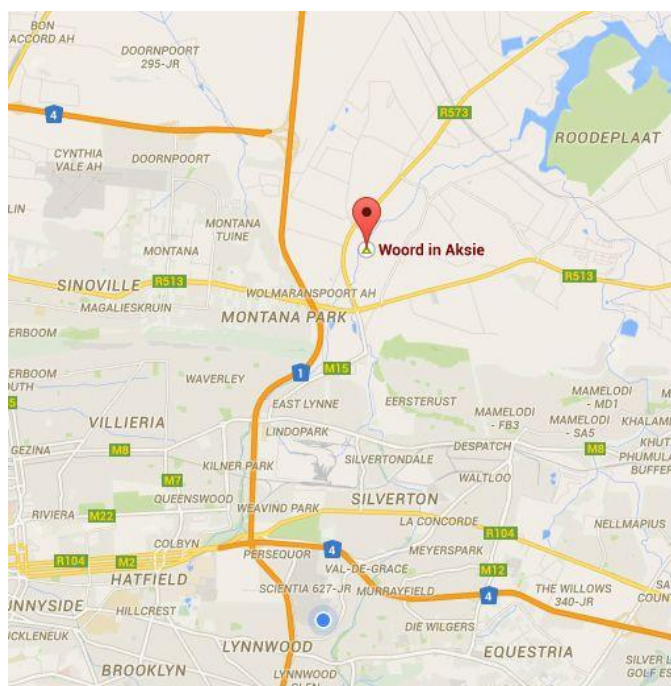
"Kick-start" camp runs from 31 January 2021 - 3 February 2021. After the camp, we will arrive at the church around 15:00 in busses. It is **compulsory** for all students to come back with the bus, and therefore students **are not allowed to go to the campsite with their own cars**. If parents will not be going with to the campsite and/or transport is required, you need to arrange with Chanine, 082 924 6860, **before Friday 29 January 18:00**.

### **What to bring:**

- 1 Set of very old clothes
- 3 Sets of comfortable clothes for 3 days (T-shirts and shorts)
- Warm Clothes
- Swimwear, a swimming towel and sun block
- Toiletries bag and bath towel
- Sleepwear, sleeping bag and pillow
- A pen

### **What to bring:**

1. Cutlery and crockery: Plates, knives, forks, a glass, a coffee mug. *Pots and pans are provided*
2. Dish cloth, sponge and drying cloth (x3)
3. Washing pegs, washing powder (Automatic machines) and softener
4. Marking pen to mark your things
5. Toiletries and own facecloths/sponges and towels
6. Bedding for a single bed.
7. Own Iron (Optional)
8. **Food:** Remember, grocery space is limited and students are away on a camp. There will be enough time upon their return to buy groceries.
9. Board games etc. (optional)
10. PC or laptop (optional and may only be used or set up in a central place in the commune.)
11. Small music instruments or players
12. Car, motorbike or bicycle (Optional)
13. NO animals or insects
14. NO alcohol, electronic- and cigarettes or any drugs
