

## Target Life Bursary Fund

### *Terms & Conditions*

#### **Introduction**

We at Target Life have seen miraculous transformation in the lives of students. We realised that some students do not have the opportunity to be involved in processes that facilitate these transformations due to limited resources, specifically in term of finance. Our goal is to provide the financial resources to such individuals that they too can experience the privilege of being part of the process that Target Life offers.

#### **Why Was The Fund Established?**

The Target Life Bursary Fund was established to provide a way for students to attend our course of whom the parents' or guardians are not able to assist financially.

This fund supports students to prepare them for their future.

Successful applicants are held to high standards. By accepting a Target Life bursary or grant, a student commits him/herself to the following:

#### **Terms & Conditions**

1. A grant will be made available for a period of 1 year.
2. 50% or 100% bursary on Class fees (Commune not included) will be given on merit. The goal of our training is to provide students with an opportunity to equip them to pursue their Godly purpose with passion and perseverance.

\* With reference to the approval of a 50% bursary, the monthly class fee (50% of the normal class fee) is still to be payed by the end of each month, starting in January.

\* In the event of three months outstanding fees, the bursary will be withdrawn and the student will be held responsible for repaying the bursary, if they are unable to continue with the course.

3. All transfers of grant monies will be done internally in Target Life. No cash payments or Electronic Fund Transfers will be done.

4. The following are expected of applicants:

a) **Self-discipline:** Attendance of class times is very important. If a student fails to attend class without a valid reason provided in advance, a bursary will be withdrawn. It is also compulsory for the student to have a part time job in order to raise money for their own camp fees.

b) **Humility:** Openness to change is essential. A person must willingly make themselves accountable to change and grow in godliness.

d) **Initiative:** Have initiative in getting to know fellow students and leaders and partaking in all teambuilding exercises.

5. The Management Board of the Target Life Bursary Fund retains the right to stop any grant payments, should the gross violation of the above character traits become evident at any stage, or if any rule of Target Life or any Living Word training institution where wilfully disobeyed.

6. Participation in/exposing other students to any behaviour and activities that can be deemed inappropriate or explicit by the Target Life leadership will result in immediate disciplinary action, which may lead to expulsion. These include but are not limited to drugs, sex, intentional dishonesty as well as any deception against the leadership of Target Life.

\*If the student is expelled, the parents or guardians will be held responsible to refund the **full amount** of the bursary.

\*If the student is an orphan, the student will be held responsible to refund the full amount of the bursary within a time period of 2 years

\*In the event of an expulsion, the Parent/Guardian of the student can appeal the decision within two weeks, in which case a meeting will be scheduled with the relevant Target Life leaders.

7. The Target Life Bursary Fund is subject to the authority of Pro Dev Link trading as Target Life.
